



Gas Terminal Project

Rosewall Community Centre
Drop-in Information Session, September 17

The Viva Energy Gas Terminal project team was on hand to discuss the proposal at a public information session at the Rosewall Community Centre on September 17, between 3pm and 6pm. The team was joined by representatives from the Geelong Refinery and Viva Energy's hydrogen refuelling service station that is under construction at the Viva Energy Hub.

The session was advertised in Viva Energy's regular community newsletter, the Geelong Advertiser (Saturday, September 14) and on Facebook and Linked-In, while invitations were also emailed directly to community stakeholders via an Energy Hub e-update, with some local groups also getting direct email invitations.

The drop-in session was attended by two people and both attendees engaged in long conversations about the gas terminal project and the hydrogen refuelling service station project.

Copies of the Gas Terminal Project Supplementary Statement and 'How to Make A Submission;' documents were available.

The focus of the session was the Supplementary Statement noise session and the assessments regarding:

- Background noise monitoring to enable recalculation of noise limits;
- Pre-existing and cumulative noise impacts; and,
- Project noise criteria.

The next Gas Terminal drop-in session is at the Geelong Library and Heritage Centre on September 25, between 10am and 1.30pm.
